WHO recommend the governments to do quarantine, give awareness to the people for example wear a mask, wash the hands twice in a day, use sanitizer, do not hand shake, make 6-meter distance from the other person etc.? In the early of this pandemic our country Pakistan faced lack of medical and health care equipment's so Pakistan decided to take help from china, from where the virus started spreading. Until the government of Punjab received fulminating mercury, appliances, apparatus and virus detecting kits from the developed countries like china and japan. After sometime this virus has been controlling a little bit in Pakistan and the government of Pakistan.

Various places of the Punjab have been appointed as quarantine centers according to the guidance of WHO and these quarantine centers was look after by the NATIONAL MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY. The overseas Pakistan that was living in other countries like Taftan, Iran, Iraq, Zahedan were send back to their countries after this paramedic. At this Pakistan faced lack of quarantine centers so Pakistan have been declared three big halls beside the KAFTAN BORDER and then the overseas who send back from Iran placed in these quarantine halls for their isolation. And then after the isolation these peoples were set free and send back to their home towns. After sending back to their hometowns from the TAFTAN quarantine centers, they were again isolated when they reached their home towns and get the proper quarantine facilities.

By the side of local health care system, the public has to follow the nominated SOPs to avoid the virus. The government of Punjab Pakistan presents the SOPs to defeat this critical situation. The spread of infection in Punjab was not as high as people think but unfortunately people make this spreading of virus possible by not following the SOPs. The undisguised defy of government orders, underestimate the threat and took it inadvertently. And after all, people who still unmasked and did not follow the SOPs, will eventually face the lockdown everywhere which is not good for any one in any condition. Due to the carelessness and non-serious behavior, an expeditious leap was recorded in cases. The fledgling public reaction regarding to COVID-19 was so relaxing. In spite of all the warnings, people continued to offer prayers in massive places and public activated largely ease the wireless transmission. Pakistan is a country with a large number of illiterate people and many are far from the territory of knowledge the number of illiterate people in Pakistan is still 59% and the only 41% are literate. So, because of this lack of education and lack of general knowledge, people did not

take this as serious as they should. The spread of the virus has reduced the country's economic situation by round about 10 percent that is approximately 1 trillion rupees. Punjab is the largest economic center of Pakistan with a population of about 110,012,442 people. At present, the Government is not in favor of a complete lockdown because the country's economic situation is already very weak due to previous lockdown. That is why the country cannot tolerate one more lockdown even most of the country's population falls below the poverty line. And the majority of the population in this poor and valuable class is one of the daily earners.

The health care system in Pakistan is the fundamental duty of nation that depends on public and capitalistic system. The corona virus has the most impact on the poor people who cannot health care facilities. Assignment of doctors is needed to increase the dimension of current health staff. The total measurement of public sector's hospital and dispensaries across Pakistan was 132663. The Punjab province have highest percentage in this. Stopping is the rapidly increasing number of COVID-19 cases was making it harder for health care system in Punjab, Pakistan. The growing number of cases that were affected by the virus was in dire need of ventilation but there was a dearth of ventilators in Punjab, Pakistan.

After sometime this virus has been controlling a little bit in Pakistan and the government of Pakistan.

4.1. Possible Reasons for Spreading Corona Virus in Punjab

Punjab is the largest economic center of Pakistan with a population of about 110,012,442 people. This has suffered a loss of about 380 billion rupees. At present, the Government is not in favor of a complete lockdown because the country's economic situation is already very weak due to previous lockdown. That is

why the country cannot tolerate one more lockdown even most of the country's population falls below the poverty line. And the majority of the population in this poor and valuable class is one of the daily earners. So that people can't get out of their homers to earn money due to the strict lockdown.

Many rumors and tails were speeded related to the virus (COVID-19), which was also for the treatment and prevention and also for furthering the world of anxiety but most of them aggravate the problem. People were so intimidated at those who were not sick, became sick with anxiety. Pakistan is a country with a large number of illiterate people and many are far from the territory of knowledge the number of illiterate people in Pakistan is still 59% and the only 41% are literate. So, because of this lack of education and lack of general knowledge, people did not take this as serious as they should. As people did not keep social distancing and did not adopt health protection attitudes seriously of was very difficult for the govt to make people aware from this virus and it was else very difficult to adopt protective measures to prevent COVID-19 by illiterate people specially in less developed areas.

4.5. Fundamental, Health and Human Resource

The health care system the health care system in Pakistan is fundamentally the responsibility of nation that depends on public and capitalistic system. The nation provides get health care through three basic health care levels that are primary, secondary and upper-level care services. The corona virus has the most impact on the poor people who cannot health care facilities. One more challenge pop up national zeal was deficient human capita- doctors, nurses and paramedics. Enlargement of health care human resources that are the front line of the outbreak was required. Assignment of medical students and nurses is needed to increase the dimension of current health staff. The total measurement of public sector's hospital and dispensaries across Pakistan was 132663 beds, with Punjab having the highest percentage (45%).the administration of patients who were in critical condition needed ventilation but both government and private hospitals had a very little number of ventilators which were insufficient for the rapid increase in the new cases of this virus of corona virus. The hospital proportions and component with in the hospitals like the number of obtainable beds for impenetrable COVID-19 patients and breathing apparatus in ICU (intensive care unit) are critical factors in diminish strategies and endeavor of any country. Demand is some missive pressure on health acre departments for even the developed and established countries. As Pakistan is a poor country in which there are not so many assets of health care system so Pakistan had to face this problem a lot because there are not so many facilities of ventilators in Pakistan? In this dire situation when Pakistan was going through this difficult time it needed help a lot then Pakistan sought helped from Italy and UK (United Kingdom) and requested ventilators from both of the countries. Stopping the rapidly increasing number of COVID-19 cases was making it harder for health care system in Punjab, Pakistan. The growing number of cases that were affected by the virus was in dire need of ventilation but there was a dearth of ventilators in Punjab, Pakistan. Cases are continue to increase and the facility is not available than the disease will continue to grow and no one will able to access the ventilator facility. And then when there is no solution it is up to the health professionals to make the decisions and the decision was based on age and health status and it was decided that health and young people would be safe first and will provided with the facilities firs practically and it was decided that the govt of Punjab would provide 1000 ventilators as part of the settlement of COVID-19 out of the country's capital.

4.6. Precautionary Measurement and Quarantine

Various places of the Punjab have been appointed as quarantine centers according to the guidance of WHO (WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION) and these quarantine centers was look after by the NATIONAL MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY. The overseas Pakistan that was living in other countries like TAFTAN, IRAN, IRAQ, ZAHEDAN were send back to their countries after this pandemic. Especially from IRAN 7000 overseas send back to Pakistan immediatly. At this Pakistan faced lack of quarantine centers so Pakistan have been declared

three big halls beside the KAFTAN BORDER and then the overseas who send back from Iran placed in these quarantine halls for their isolation. And then after the isolation these peoples were set free and send back to their home towns. After sending back to their hometowns from the TAFTAN quarantine centers, they were again isolated when they reached their home towns and get the proper quarantine facilities.

5. Discussion and Analysis

Now it discusses some interviews related to how corona virus affected and what changes have taken place since the outbreak of corona virus?

This is According to Dr. Hussain Jafri, Fatima Jinnah medical university, Lahore, Pakistan. Corona has become one of the most Populous crisis, related health, economy and all those who were affected by this virus from different countries then the government around the world from different countries have taken different steps to deal with this virus (COVID-19, pandemic) due to which the economies are badly affected thus the corona virus not only affected the health crisis of the countries but also affected the economic, social and political consequences. Apart from these countries Pakistan was also affected by this time in which the number of cases increasing very rapidly of confirmed cases. Pakistan is the sixth most populated country in the world whose value of money is very low. Pakistan's economy is mainly dependent on small and medium scale manufacturing industries. Pakistan's scale on the (HDI) Human Development Index, 2019 is 152 out of 189 in the world-wide countries take place in higher percentage of the health challenges as to the generally of south Asian countries in the world. However, this was not the first time that Pakistan has suddenly faced an emergency at the national level. The public health crisis and economic downturn could be devastating, particularly if people feel it mismanaged.

According to Dr. Shahid Asad Saddique, the statistic report on the impact of the corona on the

economy, 27 million people lost their jobs during the lockdown in this pandemic. The income of 6.7 million people decreased during this pandemic and also according to the statistics agency various departments of the country were also affected like transportation, educational institutes, manufacturing, agricultural etc. corona destroyed the economy and increased unemployment and poverty and the more serious problem that unemployment has increased in the fact that it has affected people whose income were already low. The government has given many packages for industry and trade but the main issue is that the packages will not reduce unemployment for those who become unemployed. This is a very simple and practical way to do this but I don't know why the government is not paying attention to it. There are millions of people like plumbers, painters, mechanic, electrician, give the 50 thousand to one million loan from the bank but the bank says you should bring 20 percent equity because bank doesn't have a guarantee. It was suggested to the government that neither you nor the private sector can provide employment because the economy has not yet recovered. So, the government should help the people like plumber, electrician, servants, mechanics, painter etc. through Ehsas Program that if someone has to pay 2 lac rupees the government should give him 50 thousand rupees from the Ehsas Program. In this way millions of people will get jobs and Pakistan has no other solution to help the people so the State Bank and the government have to pay attention to this. I have given them a whole practical proposal the only way for Pakistan is to finance the bank and provide equity to the bank through Ehsas program.

If the government refuses this proposal, what will be the result? Because it's a big concern that many people are unemployed, many families have also been affected. On the other hand, the government of Pakistan claims that economically Pakistan did not suffer so much because of the corona lockdown as was being estimated. That's right. This is really a small loss, thank God but the policy that we have is in the interest of the powerful classes. Let me tell you a statement from the State Bank report that Pakistan has made the biggest interest rate cut in the world after the corona virus so lowering interest rates benefits those who take out loans but depositor suffer loss. so why did we cut the most because of the package that came to us, that too has come for the powerful classes for the construction sectors so until this policy is made that economic growth is very important but at the same time, if the people do not get the benefits and it is done by putting a burden on them. so that's what will happen in Pakistan until this change that is the policy to give everything to the powerful class and crush the lower class this raises the dear that the people are getting worse and disappointed. They believe in democracy is rising and they are disgusted with it and are turning to violence and related evils.

Furthermore, there is a statement of Prime minister of Pakistan Imran Khan. Overall world oil prices have fallen, exports have begun, travel industries are in bad shape, and airlines are facing difficulties so the Pakistan will face difficulties. What we see is exports will be affected, secondly businesses will be affected. Therefore, this economic committee will have only one purpose. Every day we will see which areas are being affected because of this and how can we help them? The prime minister said that we have to contact the IMF (INTERNATIONAL MONETARY FUND) to provide relief to the public.

According to the economic expert Dr Hafeez pasha, first of all one thing that is in our favor in this scenario is the price of oil. Now the price of oil has halved and as a result our export threat could be as low as 4 billion and one of the great things about it is that there is a capacity for a reduction of about 35 percent in the price and if the government can do half of it in addition to its revenue and half of it has pass on to the consumers so it can be an infidel facility for us in inflation. It is estimated that the inflation rate was 12.4 percent at the time of your previous month, due to the shortage of oil alone; it could be as low as 11 percent. However, there are many effects that are well documented that our exports may be affected and the three our marketers USA, CHINA, EUROPIAN COUNTRIES if we combine these three so about 60

percent of our exports go to these markets and from there, the situation will be that the orders have started to stop. And many of our exporters are worried because the orders we used to have are now gone so the exports has had the bad effect. On the other hand, in the Middle East, whose oil revenues have fallen their budgets are running deficit, especially in Saudi Arabia. So, there are two dangers, one is that they will start sending workers back and on the other hand your remittances will be affected. The prime minister said that we have to contact the IMF (INTERNATONA MONETRY FUND) to provide relief to the public. The doctor said that the most disturbing thing is that if we have to close the shops and markets for a while now, we have to work, then the most affected class is the working class which also works on daily wages Yes, and it works every day We estimate that there are 50,000 such workers in cities across the country and so people can be very badly affected and people will be very upset so you should announce the relief package. This could lead to two things: one is the people whose house was running because of Benazir's income support. But you see, in our budge we kept Rs 180 crore. The government has spent only Rs 27 billion in the first six months. So, there is room for you to double. Double the stipend you pay on the support base. On the other hand, you should have brought an intensive package. Now you see that the reduction in interest rates by the State Bank of Pakistan is negligible. Only .75 percent of the point is that the interest is still being charged 12 percent. At present, the trade of relief and intensive association of industry and import-export are very much needed. Export orders bill has stopped. I wanted to bring exporters to 10%. On the other hand, you should have helped the exporters. You should have reverted to the zero rating you removed for a while. All you have to do is bring them back. You just have to be more flow with the help you render toward other people. One thing that has been agreed with the IMF is good has agreed with the government that extra-ordinary expenses will not be included in the government's circle. So, it was a good opportunity for the Prime Minister to make the announcement at the same time so that those who were worried would be relieved of their worries. There would be some established associations in our market and gradually things would start to get better. Of course, the government can do that, after this pandemic, it seems to me that our country's economy will be destroyed.

6. Conclusion

The Punjab province of Pakistan faced a lot of hardships to prevent this virus affected the education of children and adults. The health system was also affected badly. The biggest reason for the spread of the corona virus was that (Aslam & Akram, May 2020) people did not follow the SOP's (Standard Operating Procedures) and thought that the virus and to control this virus. Invest in the health care system and fulfil their basic who are working in this pandemic for the prevention of covid-19 situation. Economy of Pakistan was also very affected by the corona virus. the price of oil has halved and as a result our export threat could be as low as 4 billion and one of the great things about it is that there is a capacity for a reduction of about 35 percent in the price and if the government can do half of it in addition to its revenue and half of has pass on to the consumers so it can be an infidel facility for us in inflation.
